## Symbolism of the wall objects

Each detail in Tekija has its precise meaning. The weapons displayed on the walls symbolise the fight struggle with one's own self as the most gracious choice. There is always a levha stating: "Beware, the swords displayed on the wall will know if you misbehave: fight with all your being"

The bow and arrows hanging on the wall are urging for caution in life, representing the passing time and the proximity of death, because as a released arrow, the time is irreversible.

There is always a crutch which has a strong meaning in Islam, and it represents the tradition, and leaning on tradition which is passed from generation to generation for centuries.
